Dear Warwick Valley School Community,

We are excited to announce that starting **Tuesday, December 15, 2020**, the Warwick Valley Central School District will be offering free breakfast and lunch to all elementary school students (Grades K-4) whether they are learning in our schools or remotely. Remote learners interested in breakfast or lunch should contact the Food Service Department.

Because the District uses the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) for the elementary schools and is able to seek reimbursement of meal costs under the Federal Seamless Summer Option Program (SSO), the District can offer free meals to all elementary school students (Grades K-4). Unfortunately, the program is not available to our Middle and High School students.

Sanfordville and Park Elementary students will be able to take a Grab & Go Breakfast back to their classroom as they enter the building in the morning. Elementary students will also have the option of choosing either a hot lunch or cold lunch daily once in the classroom, which will be delivered during their in-class lunch period. This will eliminate the use of the on-line order form.


Pine Island Elementary students will continue to follow the on-line order form for both breakfast and lunch. Breakfast and lunch will be delivered to their classrooms each day.

The breakfast and lunch menu will continue to be posted on line. Any allergy concerns should be directed to the Food Service Department.
