## Tips for Students Who Are Struggling

- Go in during unit lunch/ after school with your teacher for extra help
- Make sure you are completing all homework and studying for exams/ quizzes at home
- Go to after school NHS/ Mu Alpha Theta Peer Tutoring (Every Thursday after school from 2:40pm-3:30pm)
- Get 1 on 1 tutoring from an NHS member (Tutoring Request forms are available in the Guidance Office)





# **AP Registration and Payment**

If you are taking an AP class/classes and plan to take the exam in May, the deadline to register AND pay for the exam without penalty is November 15th at noon. After this date and time, you will be required to pay a \$40 per exam late fee.

### This is a 2 step process:

- 1) Join the AP classroom for your class on the CollegeBoard website/app
- 2) Pay for the exam/exams in Total Registration

### BOTH STEPS MUST BE COMPLETED TO HAVE AN EXAM ORDERED.

# **FAFSA Rollout**

### Prepare to complete the 2025-26 FAFSA

- Students are to create their <u>StudentAid.gov</u> account (FSA ID) and identify which parents will be required to contribute to their FAFSA application. Learn more about <u>who is considered a contributor</u>.
- Federal Student Aid continues to share information and resources to support students and families in preparing for the 2025-26 FAFSA, including a recent revision to provide an estimation of the Student Aid Index (SAI) and federal Pell Grant eligibility calculation.
- FSA will continue to share the latest FAFSA information and updates, so be sure to visit the Federal Student Aid <u>YouTube</u> channel and their website, <u>Federal Student Aid</u>, for guidance and tools.

# 2025-26 New York State Tuition Assistance Program Application will open December 1.

- The application will be available at <a href="ny.gov/nystap">ny.gov/nystap</a>.
- Students will need to create a <u>HESCPIN</u> in order to access the TAP application.

## **COLLEGE APPLICATION SEASON IS HERE!**

During September and October counselors met with all seniors to discuss post high school planning.

Post high school options include:

- 4-year colleges
- · 2-year colleges
- Trade schools
- Work
- · Gap year

Completing applications takes a good deal of dedicated time and energy, so plan ahead!!!

The transcript request form is found in the Guidance Google Classroom Class of 2025.

\*Pay strict attention to deadlines and requirements and understand that counselors require a minimum of two (2) weeks to process your letters of recommendation and transcripts\*

Remember that you have an abundance of resources available to you, from your counselor, to Naviance, to the guidance google classroom...use your resources wisely!

\*\*Seniors should regularly check their emails/Guidance Google Classroom for reminders, updates and community service opportunities. \*\*

ASVAB exam November 13th for any seniors interested in the military.

The 20 community service hours needed for graduation for the class of 2025 is due by the end of the third marking period (4/30/2025). If your student does not have the required hours, please have them complete community service opportunities in the near future.

Decision notifications from these applications will generally arrive via email or mail mid-December. Be sure to let your counselor know the results of all of your admissions decisions!

#### **FAFSA**

Prepare to complete the 2025-26 FAFSA

Students are to create their studentaid.gov account (FSA ID) and identify which parents/guardians will be required to contribute to their FAFSA application. Learn more about who is considered a contributor. <u>Higher Education Services Corporation</u> (HESC) offers a variety of online resources to help students and families better understand the federal and state financial aid process and plan and pay for college.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS**

Counselors will be visiting senior classrooms during the end of January to walk seniors through the scholarship process and help them navigate how to apply to local scholarships.

# Juniors

#### **PSAT Results**

In early fall, counselors shared information about the PSAT with the 10th and 11th grade students. The PSAT was administered on October 26th at WVHS.

The PSAT scores will be available during the middle of November for students who took the exam on 10/26. If you need help understanding your scores, please sign up to attend the workshop. Counselors will help walk students through the score report. The PSAT should provide a context for what work needs to be done in order to prepare for the SAT or ACT, as well as a base score range to use in considering potential colleges. Scores will be released on 11/14.

### **College Planning**

Juniors - it is never too early to get a head start on looking at colleges! College representatives visit our high school during unit lunch a few times a week. Come stop by and meet the representatives that will one day be reviewing your applications. This is a great way to get more information about schools and ask questions.

Juniors begin to look at when SAT/ACT exams will be offered in the spring. We recommend juniors take their first SAT/ACT during the spring of their junior year.

Junior year is a big year to showcase your potential in classes. Make sure to put your best foot forward for the final three quarters. If you have struggled so far this year do not forget it is a long year and your final average is not determined by one quarter.

#### **Students with Testing Accommodations**

Students with existing testing accommodations must submit an application to receive such accommodations on any standardized testing (PSAT, SAT, ACT or AP exams). Please contact your counselor to apply. Completing these forms does not guarantee that you will receive accommodations, but allows the college board and/or act to review whether you are eligible. The college board application only needs to be completed once during your high school career and the act application needs to be filled out for each test.

January 17, 2025 for the March 8th SAT January 24, 2025 for May AP Exams March 14, 2025 for the May 3th SAT April 18, 2025 for the June 7th SAT
